



## STATEMENT OF SCOPE 1 AND 2 CARBON EMISSIONS FOR THE YEAR 1/8/23 TO 31/7/24

### 1. Application:

This audit data applies to legacy City, University of London and comprises emissions attributed to the Clerkenwell and Moorgate campuses.

### 2. Methodology adopted:

This data has been gathered and is reported in accordance with the standards of the Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (2019), from the World Resources Institute (WRI) and the World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD).

### 3. Net Zero Target:

City University of London has set a net zero target across Scopes 1, 2 and 3 by 2040.
