



REGULATION 8

STUDENTS, OCCASIONAL STUDENTS AND APPLICANTS

1 General

Students and Occasional Students of City St George's, University of London (the University), are defined by this Regulation.

2 Students

Any individuals pursuing programmes of study are defined as students of the University. A programme of study means full-time or part-time study at undergraduate or postgraduate level leading to an award.

3 Occasional Students

Any individuals pursuing schemes of study in the institution are defined as "Occasional Students". A scheme of study means full-time or part-time study at any level which does not in itself lead to an award. Occasional students may study modules which are offered as part of award-bearing programmes. Occasional students may also be issued with a Certificate of Achievement, Certificate of Credit or Certificate of Attendance on completion of the scheme; these do not, however, constitute an award of the University.

4 Applicants

Any individuals who have submitted an application to study to the University. It covers the application and pre-registration period up to completion of registration at the start of the individuals University course.
