J.4. MEETING OF THE STAKEHOLDERS (“THE COURT”)

J.4.1 PURPOSE

The University’s Supplemental Charter and Statutes provide for a Stakeholders’ meeting which shall have a name, composition and membership and functions prescribed by the Council, as the governing body of the University. The Council has determined that this Meeting shall be known as “The Court” and will have the following terms of reference, duties, and composition.

J.4.2 TERMS OF REFERENCE

To receive the Vice-Chancellor and President’s Report.

The Meeting of Stakeholders has no delegated authority from Council, meets as required, and has no quoracy requirement.

J.4.3 COMPOSITION

- i. Rector (Chair)
- ii. Members of Council
- iii. Members of Senate
- iv. Co-opted members of Council committees
- v. Honorary Fellows and Honorary Graduates
- vi. One representative from each of the City Livery Companies. Stakeholders from the communities that City seeks to serve, including, but not limited to: the City of London Corporation, Islington Council and Professional Associations
- vii. Representatives from the Alumni Association, the Students’ Union and Student Ambassadors
- viii. Representatives from Collaborative Institutions or Partnerships
- ix. Representatives from other local Educational Bodies
- x. Representatives from OfS, UUK, QAA, Research Councils and other sector bodies
- xi. Individuals nominated by the Vice-Chancellor and President or Pro-Chancellor and Chair of Council.
