



## Study and Travel Fund 2026-2027

Terms & Conditions for 2026-2027 academic year of entry:

1. Students must meet all the eligibility criteria set for the Study and Travel Fund as follows:

- Ordinarily resident in England;
- New full-time enrolled entrants to City St George's starting their first year in 2026-2027 of an undergraduate degree course: BA, BEng, BSc, MBBS, MEng\*, MOptom\*, MSc\*;
- Eligible for student finance through Student Finance England;
- Household income equal to or less than £20,000 as assessed by Student Finance England (SFE) by 31 May 2027.

\*Undergraduate route only

2. Students must be registered at City St George's by 31 October 2026. Both student and their sponsors (where applicable) must give consent to share their household income information with City St George's, University of London by 31 May 2027 through Student Finance England (SFE) only. Students' financial information shared from 1 June 2027 onwards will not be considered and students will not be considered for a grant during the 2026-2027 academic year.

3. Students must be starting the first year of their undergraduate degree as a new student (i.e. those starting in Year 2, Year 3 or Year 4 are not eligible).

4. Students must be ordinarily resident in England. Students who normally live in Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland are not eligible.

5. Students in receipt of a grant may also receive the Young Adult Carer Bursary (but not the Care Leavers, Care Experienced, Estranged Bursary or Sanctuary Scholarship).

6. A change in students' enrolment status from full-time to dormant, suspended, part-time or withdrawn – will result in students becoming ineligible for the grant for that academic year. Under these circumstances, the next instalment of the grant will be cancelled and any grant payment already received for that academic year may need to be repaid by the student to

City St George's or deducted from their remaining entitlement for the grant in proceeding academic years (if eligible).

7. The grant is payable for each progressive year of study of a BA, BEng, BSc, MEng, MBBS, MOptom and MSc.

8. The grant will not be paid during part-time or full-time repeat academic years, dormant/suspended periods, during a placement year or study abroad year.

9. The grant will be paid in three equal instalments in November, January and April each academic year.

10. Grant renewal: students must continue to meet all the Fund eligibility criteria each academic year, as follows:

a) Students' household income as assessed by SFE must remain at equal to or less than £20,000. Both student and their sponsors (where applicable) must give consent to share their household income information with City St George's, University of London by 31 May each academic year;

b) Students must be enrolled full-time on the next progressive year of study of their degree course;

c) Where a student may transfer to a new course, any grant already paid for a year of study will be deducted from any remaining grant entitlement and paid in the latter years of the degree course.

11. The following categories of students are not eligible:

- Students directly continuing from one course to another (for example from a foundation degree or HND on to the final year of an honours degree);
- Students undertaking a foundation course, introduction certificate, postgraduate qualification, online or short courses;
- Students studying part-time.
